<u>Mount Gretna Campmeeting</u>: Total gallons pumped to the Mount Gretna Campmeeting for the month of January was 761,758; Average Gallons per Day was 24,573.

The Campmeeting's project is on schedule according to the contractor. Footers are being dug today. Water will be turned off to Campmeeting residents tomorrow in order to install a new 6" gate value for the new tank.

**Princeton Avenue/Chautauqua Drive Project:** A quote for the installation of 1,200' of trenchless 6" water main from Harvard Avenue, north on Princeton Avenue to Chautauqua Drive and then west to Carnegie Avenue, then south on Carnegie to the upper entrance to the parking area where a new 8" water main is to be located. L & N Zimmerman is working on providing this quote. Zimmerman will install the main and our staff will do the service line connections on Harvard Avenue, etc.

There were no issues with the wells or system.
